# 9. Agenda Items

a) Wales Audit Office [item moved to Part 4 of the meeting]
Mr. Deryk Evans [Welsh Audit Office] advised:

#### **Clerk Remuneration**

- To pay the Clerk after he worked unpaid for twelve months may be illegal.
- Should be from the date of resignation.

MM Highlighted reasoning behind resignation timing.

- Recommend cessation of payment cannot enforced by WAO.
- 'Unlikely' to lead to legal action as cost of pursuing this would be of not be in the public interest.
- However, Auditor General will have the final say.
- LIMCC will be prosecuted as a corporate body not individuals.

#### **Council Aims and Objectives**

- LIMCC needs to decide how it wants to work for the community.
- Council needs to be 'forward looking' and proactive'.
- Only items on the agenda can be *discussed* and *voted* upon

# **Councillor Conduct**

- Minutes highlight a 'pettiness' and 'childishness' during meetings.
- Warned such traits that have been considered as 'bullying behaviour' in cases brought against Councils and individuals evident in meetings.
- JH: Stated Clerk is *not* bullied Clerk *is* a bully. Councillors think the same. Requested Cllrs who opposed this opinion identify themselves.

#### Statement from Welsh Audit Office

I attended the meeting at the council's request to provide some commentary on issues facing the council. As part of this I intended to talk the council through the governance framework but was requested to address the specific questions directly.

I left copies of my presentation with the council.

In introducing my session, I commented on the impression I'd drawn from reading the minutes from previous minutes. My impression is that the council is failing to work cohesively. Various issues have arisen in the past and mean the council has let down its community. It now needs to pull together to move forward.

A specific question was raised regarding the clerk's salary. As a former member, the law states that the clerk cannot be appointed to a paid office until 12 months after he ceases to be a member.

On this basis the expenditure is *potentially* unlawful. It is not the Auditor General's role to make a declaration that the expenditure is unlawful. Instead he has the power to apply to the courts for such a declaration. Before doing so he will take into account whether or not it is in the public interest to do so.

Various factors will inform his consideration including the circumstances surrounding the award of the payments, the value of the payments made and the cost of making the application (these would be passed on to the council).

The issue itself is timebound in that 12 months after the clerk resigned his membership any payments would be lawful.
