- FP.10: Clear Complete Path to Junction of FP.1
- FP.14: Llan Road to Cwmfelin Primary School

If these paths are cleared, another circular walk would be available for the public to use.

RM also recommended that the Council purchase the latest edition of a book 'Rights of Way: Guide to Law and Practice' by John Riddall and John Trevelyan at approximately £40; members were in agreement.
